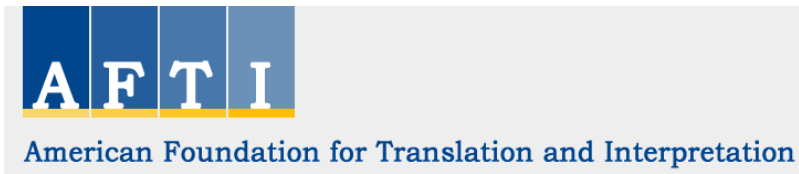

The American Foundation for Translation and Interpreting (AFTI) is pleased to offer **five \$500.00 scholarships** to students or recent graduates of translation or interpreting studies programs to partially defray the cost of attending the 2019 ATA Conference in Palm Springs, California, October 23-26, 2019. Applicants should note the following guidelines:

- Current students:
 - Can be **full-time or part-time** students at the **undergraduate or graduate** level
 - Must be enrolled at a **two-year or four-year college or university** in a program in **translation, interpretation, or both**, leading to an **academic degree or certificate**
- Recent graduates must have completed their program within twelve months of the starting date of the 2019 ATA Conference.
- Applicants will be ranked based on:
 - Grade Point Average
 - Nearness to graduation
 - Answers to questions in the Scholarship Application
 - ATA Student Membership (preferred but not required)
- Scholarships must be used to partially cover the costs of 2019 ATA Conference registration fees, airfare or other travel, and/or lodging.
- Students must not have previously received an AFTI Conference Attendance Scholarship.
- Students who are awarded an AFTI Student Conference Attendance Scholarship must commit to attending the entire ATA Conference.

- This completed AFTI Conference Attendance Scholarship **application form**
- Proof of student status, by either of the following:
 - A **letter** from a department chair, dean or administrator (with your name in filename)
 - A copy of an official or unofficial **transcript** issued by your school registrar's office showing enrollment in and/or completion of program within twelve months of the starting date of the 2019 ATA Conference.
- A current **resume**
